In order to accelerate clinical and fundamental research, towards the development of new therapeutic strategies, the International DM Consortium Meeting was created in 1997 to bring together not only scientists and clinicians but also family associations and patients. For its 10th edition, the IDMC meeting will return to Paris where it started. While about 80 participants attended IDMC-1, up to 4 times more participants are expected to attend this new edition, demonstrating new challenges and the growing forces devoted to unravel disease mechanisms, to ameliorate patients' lives and to finally cure the disease. Time has come now for the development of innovative therapeutic strategies, while the knowledge on various aspects of myotonic dystrophy (biological, clinical, and psycho-social) is still progressing. IDMC-10 will give us the opportunity to acknowledge and celebrate the international effort put together to tackle this disease.

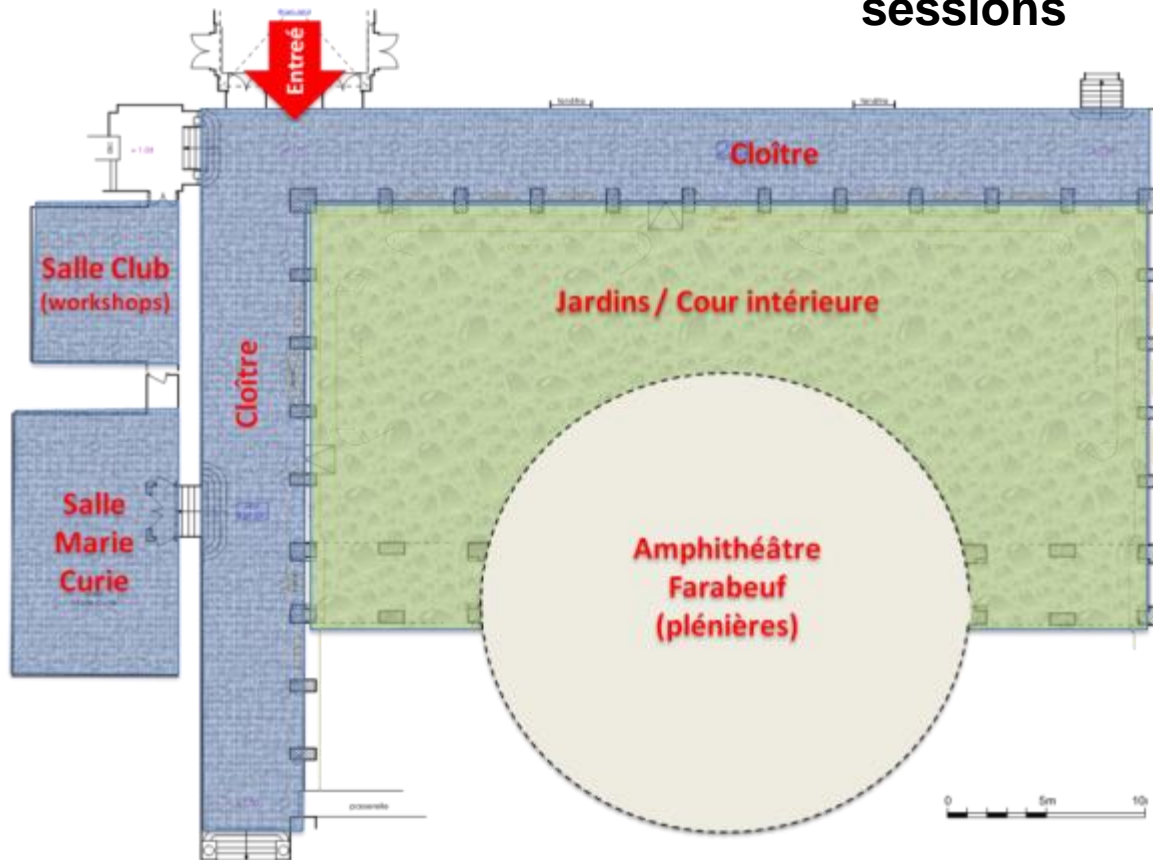

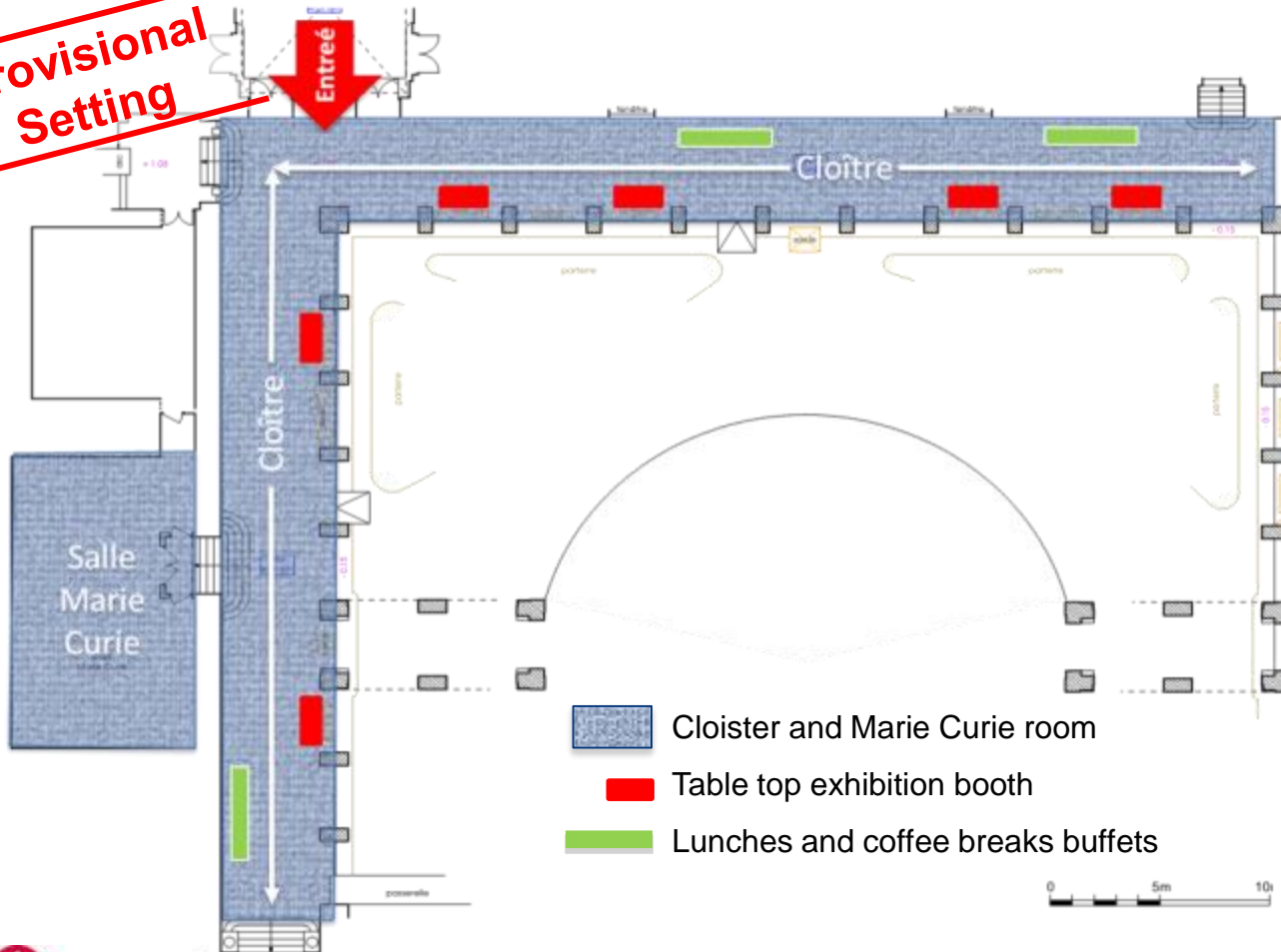
